## *A Note from Ms. Pierce*

Families,

We are working very hard to keep our students and staff safe and healthy during the COVID-19 pandemic and flu season. We need your help. Symptoms can include, but are not limited to: fever 100.4 or higher, chills, sore throat, cough (new onset or uncontrolled), shortness of breath, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain, headache (new onset of severe headache), or new loss of taste or smell. Also, just a friendly reminder that if anyone in your household receives a COVID test, please quarantine the entire household until results are received. All second grade students will participate in the Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT) standardized test on Monday November, 30th. It is a three part assessment (number analogies, picture analogies, figure matrices ) and students do not need any advance preparation for this test. This test score is just one of several data points used as a first step screener to determine high ability programming for students. Based on the results of the CogAT assessment, students may be referred for further testing next spring. This data will help determine participation in our high ability program.
